

Thank you for sponsoring an American Graffiti Trading Card! As seen on the samples to the right, the front side of the card will have a photograph or image along with "American Graffiti", the card number and this year's Salute logo. On backside will be the copy about you, your company and/or your vehicle.

1) **Photograph:** If Cruisin' The Boulevard is providing the image for your card, skip to item #2 below. Each card measures 2" x 3.5", so we will be reducing the photo you submit to fit this format with an allowance for a "bleed" on all four sides (which is why you see the photo at the right running outside of the border). This is necessary for printing.

Please submit a high resolution image in either jpeg (.jpg or .jpeg) or tiff (.tif) format. Ideally this should be 300 dpi, which means a photo taken with a phone camera will not work. Nor will a photo that is embedded in Word or Publisher. Typically, any high end 35mm digital camera set for highest resolution will work just fine, as will many current model 6+ megapixel cameras, set to the highest resolution. Do NOT reduce the size of the photo. We will do that here. If you're not sure, send the photo and we'll let you know.

2) **Copy for backside:** If you are sponsoring just a photo, we need the year, make and model of the vehicle; and the owner's name, city and state. If you are sponsoring the entire card, what you want on the backside is entirely up to you. #1 and #2 are good suggestions. Keep it simple! If you're a business, #1 is a perfect format. All cards will include the first three lines as shown in #3. Please do not ask for a specific card number or for your logo to be included! For continuity and ease of preparation all cards will utilize the same font.

How to submit copy & photograph: Using Windows notepad, create a text file (.txt) containing the copy you want for the backside.

Subject: AG Trading Card (followed by your last name)
Message: It's up to you if you want to include a message. Attach the files and click send. (You may also place the files in a folder, zip the folder and send the zipped folder.)

Upon receipt of your files, I will email you an acknowledgment. If you don't hear from me within 48 hours, be sure my email isn't trapped in your spam folder.
